



# Yukon Literacy Coalition



This summer, starting June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020, the Yukon Literacy Coalition (YLC) is supporting and offering opportunities and guidance to Yukon youth (12-18 years old) who want to work for themselves. The Yukon Literacy Coalition will help with start-up costs, marketing, budgeting and anything else we can do to make your summer project a success.

If you are a Yukon youth, or the guardian of a Yukon youth and you want to start any kind of business, we can help. You can apply as a group, individually or on behalf of a youth. Business ideas could be a baby-sitting service, lawn-care and mowing, a lemonade stand, detailing cars or painting fences and houses. Or if you're interested in doing community service work or helping people in your neighborhood by doing things like delivering groceries to people in quarantine, doing yard clean-up for elders in your community, brush clean-up, garbage pick-up or anything else that would improve your community we love to help support that as well!

To apply for the program, you will have to follow these two steps:

1. Complete the [application form](#) and submit it to us, either at our office or by completing the online form, which includes who you are and what you want to do.
2. Have a parent or guardian fill out a consent page if you're under 18 years old.

You can pick up a hard copies of all the forms at our office, Suite 207-100 Main St. Whitehorse or you can find a printable copy on our website [www.yukonliteracy.com](http://www.yukonliteracy.com). There are no set start and finish times, but resources are limited so submit your form as soon as possible.

After we have received your completed application form, had a chance to review it and the consent page (if required), a YLC staff member will contact you directly by phone or email if you have been successful in the application. We will work with you to get your project up and running as soon as possible!

Once you've started, we'll put together a plan on how we can keep in touch with you over the summer to help out where we can and track how you're doing. We have a lot of great resources that can help you succeed and also show you how to save, invest and budget any money you earn!
